Fall Membership & Fundraising Update

I'm pleased to report great news: 100 of the 127 residential property owners have paid 2022 membership dues. That's a record 78.7%!

Most of you will recall that 2022 is the final year of our 5 year campaign to raise \$25,000 annually -- \$125,000 in total-- to manage current and future AIS threats to Pleasant Lake. So far this year 82 members have generously donated \$11,273. That puts us at only 64.5% of our goal. With less than 2 months remaining, there's still time for you to donate, or even make a second donation, before the campaign ends on December 31st. A final campaign report will be published in the Spring 2023 newsletter.

Remember that the PLIA has been granted 501(c)(3) status by the IRS, meaning that donations are deductible for members who itemize. Also, if you need to take an RMD from your IRA this year, please consider a QCD to the PLIA. That's lots of initials, but it means you can make a tax-free donation from your tax-deferred retirement savings. (Check with your tax professional to do it 'by-the-book".)

Once again, thanks very much for your financial support of the PLIA!

Pleasant Lake Invasive Update

Starry Stonewort (SSW): This year PLIA contracted dives looking for SSW on the county landing 4 times, during which SSW was found twice. The first time it was about a pound, and the second time was a couple of plants. It was manually harvested and treated with Mizzen each time. A dive was also done at the city landing, and none was found.

Overall, there was more SSW at the county landing but we did not find it anywhere else in the lake. Steve McComas, from Blue Water Science, stated after two divers checked the county landing in October, that a couple of small plants were found. We will repeat the same plan next year.

Eurasian Watermilfoil (EWM): This summer the PLIA had multiple surveys done. No EWM was found for the third year. We will continue to do these surveys, and treat if found.

Curlyleaf Pondweed (CLP): We had a delineation survey completed and a chemical treatment applied to a total of 20 acres by the city landing, the county landing, and the West end of the lake. The PLIA plans on treating 20 acres next year.

Zebra Mussels: We will continue to monitor the effect on the lake. I'm sure you have noticed a significant amount of mussels on your docks and lifts this Fall.

Finally, the PLIA had a **whole lake survey** completed in October to look for any new areas of invasive species and treat them. No new AIS were found during this survey.

Note: Every year the PLIA applies for DNR grant money to help pay for treatments. This year we did not receive any as the funds were distributed by a lottery system. This makes your AIS donation even more important! Thank you!


