Treasurer Harkman presented his report in a new format which was approved. There is a balance of \$5,155 in our account. Chair Sedey will put in the request to Wright County Cola for a \$5000 reimbursement for 2015 water treatment and the water survey.

Membership remains at 91 residents for 2015.

Directors Boie and S. Miller reported on the Wright County COLA meeting held on November 10, 2015. Highlights included:

A discussion about Zebra Mussel Monitoring Evidence of a new AIS called Starry Stonewort which has been found in Lake Koronis DNR funds available to Lake Associations are gone. Wright County Soil & Water Conservation District will instead be given \$240,000 per year for distribution to the following areas:

Education: \$20,000 Weed Treatment: \$60,000 Inspection: \$109,000 Decontamination: \$50,000 (not spent) There is a Clean water Fund of \$150,000 for major projects

The Lake Survey Report completed by Wenck was reviewed and discussed. No Eurasian water milfoil was found. Curley Leaf Pondweed has expanded. It was decided that a special meeting should be held inviting a representative from Wenck to address the report and help us make decisions going forward. Chairman Sedey will contact Wenck and set a time in early December.

Director Boie reported that we have been contacted by the Downtown Council asking Lake Associations to participate in the Holiday Parade scheduled for December 12th. He will contact Vice Chair Hogberg, Director Mader and Gloria Warner to determine the interest level.

It was decided that any Year Round Renters on the lake could be approached for membership in the association.
